The following persons are disqualified from being Directors of the Corporation:

- (a) Person less than eighteen (18) years of age;
- (b) Persons who, pursuant to an order, are declared to be mentally incompetent persons or incapable of managing their affairs;
- (c) Persons against whom receiving orders have been made or who have made an assignment under the Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act, and are undischarged from such bankruptcy;
- (d) Persons who are not residents of Canada; and
- (e) Persons who are not Members of the Corporation.

The following persons are disqualified from being Directors of the Corporation:

- (a) Persons less than eighteen (18) years of age;
- (b) Persons who, pursuant to an order, are declared to be mentally incompetent persons or incapable of managing their affairs;
- (c) Persons against whom receiving orders have been made or who have made an assignment under the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act*, and are undischarged from such bankruptcy; and
- (d) Persons who are not residents of Canada;
